**Promotion Criteria**

Minimum 33% marks in each subject (Theory + Practical) required for promotion.
For internal subjects (like Work Education, Art Education, Physical Education), grades will be awarded.
Students must appear in all periodic tests and term exams. Absence without valid reason may lead to withholding of promotion.
Re-exam or improvement test may be given only on medical grounds or with Principal's approval.

**Co-Scholastic Areas**

Regularity
Sincerity
Participation
Output
Team spirit and behavior

**Attendance Rule**

Minimum 75% attendance is mandatory to be eligible for promotion and to appear in the final exam.

**Record Maintenance**

#Teachers must maintain proper records of tests, assignments, and attendance.

#Result sheets and mark registers will be verified by the Head of Department and Principal before finalization.

**Special Provisions**

#Students showing continuous improvement may be considered for promotion even if slightly below the pass percentage, after review by the Promotion Committee.

#Parents will be informed after each evaluation through PTMs and report cards.
